


#### ALL ABOUT... The Platypus



Walruses are extremely fat. Their layers of fat (blubber) keep them warm in the freezing conditions. Walruses have 3-foot-long tusks, which are used to help them out of the water, to dig holes in the ice and to defend against predators.

Walruses can live up to forty years.
