Outside, a bird screeched.

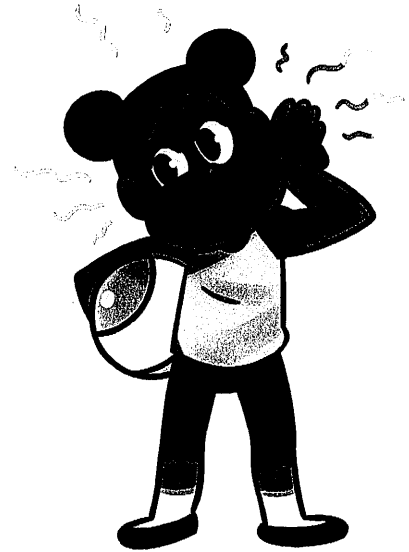
